

Term 4 Scholarship

Description:

The IEEE Newfoundland and Labrador Section is pleased to announce this year's competition for the Term 4 Scholarship. The scholarship may be awarded annually to a student who is enrolled in either Electrical or Computer Engineering. The objectives are: (1) to increase student interest in and recognition of the IEEE; (2) to enhance a promising student's ability to succeed at the undergraduate level and (3) to assist the student in pursuing his or her academic and professional goals. The amount of this one-time scholarship is \$1000.

Administration:

The scholarship is administered by Memorial University and is awarded on the advice of the Newfoundland and Labrador Section of the IEEE.

Eligibility:

A student must be (1) in Term 4 of the Electrical or Computer Engineering Programme at Memorial University, (2) an **ACTIVE** IEEE student member, and (3) of scholarship standing as defined by the University.

Application Procedure:

Interested students must **submit a one-page application letter**, including their IEEE membership number and describing their IEEE involvement, their student activities in electrical and/or computer engineering, and their professional goals to the IEEE Scholarships and Awards Chair (<u>thumeerawa@mun.ca</u>).
