

Term 6 Scholarship

Description:

The IEEE Newfoundland and Labrador Section is pleased to announce this year's competition for the Term 6 Scholarship. The scholarship may be awarded annually to a student who is enrolled in either Electrical or Computer Engineering. The objectives are: (1) to increase student interest in and recognition of the IEEE; (2) to enhance a promising student's ability to succeed at the undergraduate level and (3) to assist the student in pursuing his or her academic and professional goals. The amount of this one-time scholarship is \$1000.

Administration:

The scholarship is administered by Memorial University and is awarded on the advice of the Newfoundland and Labrador Section of the IEEE.

Eligibility:

A student must be (1) in Term 6 of the Electrical or Computer Engineering Program at Memorial University, (2) an ACTIVE IEEE student member, and (3) of scholarship standing as defined by the University. All eligible students are encouraged to apply. However, priority will be given to the individual who has not received the IEEE term 4 award.

Application Procedure:

Interested students must submit a one-page letter of application describing their IEEE involvement, their student activities in the areas of electrical and/or computer engineering, and their professional goals to the IEEE Scholarships and Awards Chair (thumeerawa@mun.ca).

Application Deadline: Oct. 10, 2022.
