



**IEEE Graduate Scholarship – IEEE NL Section
Call for Applications
2024**

Description:

The IEEE Newfoundland and Labrador Graduate Scholarship has been established to recognize Graduate Students at Memorial University that have achieved high academic standing and made contributions to the IEEE.

Award:

The scholarship will be awarded annually in the Winter semester. The recipient will be awarded a scholarship of \$1000 and presented with a certificate.

Eligibility:

Graduate students must be IEEE members and full-time graduate students at least one year into their program at Memorial University and be of high academic standing. The scholarship can be awarded to students in any field of study if it falls into one of the IEEE fields of interest.

Any previous awards or scholarships received from the IEEE Newfoundland and Labrador Section will not affect eligibility. This scholarship can only be awarded once to a student during their program of study.

Selection Process:

A subcommittee of the IEEE Newfoundland and Labrador Section will select the scholarship winner. The committee will consist of the Awards Chair and up to two additional members (decided by the Section Chair and the Awards Chair). The committee will consider the student's academic standing, including course grades and scholarly publications. The committee will also consider any contributions made to the IEEE. These contributions can be made at any level of the IEEE (local section, conferences, technical societies, etc.) and should be detailed in the student's application letter.

Application deadline:

February 29, 2024

Application package:

Students wishing to apply will be asked to provide the following.

- a letter of application summarizing the research excellence, scholarly contributions to any IEEE fields of interest, and other contributions to IEEE (volunteer activities e.g., reviewer, technical chair, IEEE conference or event organizer/volunteer, executive member of IEEE society, etc.). Indicate the starting date of the graduate studies at Memorial University and the IEEE membership number.
- a curriculum vitae,
- academic transcript, and
- a list of publications.
